LINESIDE FENCING ON THE EAST COAST MAINLINE

CPMS were contracted by Network Rail to replace a section of compromised lineside fencing.

The project comprised of the following:

- All works were planned and delivered within one week of receiving the initial job enquiry.
- CPMS liaised with Network Rail staff to utilise booked Line Blockages.
- The down-taking and removal from site of 60 metres of closeboarded wooden fencing.
- Erection of 1.5metre high powder coated "Paladin" anti-climb fencing.
- The installation of temporary fencing to maintain lineside security between shifts.
- The repositioning of lineside signage to prevent conflict with the new fence-line.
- All works were undertaken during nightshift working, on the door steps of four neighbouring properties. Works were completed on time and budget without any complaints or issues.
